

NATIONAL DEFENCE STRATEGY OBJECTIVES OF THE REPUBLIC OF RUEKEHI

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This document outlines the core objectives of Ruekehi's National Defence Strategy. These objectives align with the National Security Strategy and provide clear direction for organising, equipping, and employing the armed forces to protect the nation. These objectives respond directly to the risks identified in our National Security Threat Matrix, which maps core national interests against principal threats and recommended policy responses.

2.0 CORE OBJECTIVES

- Defend Ruekehi's territorial integrity and sovereignty: Maintain a credible deterrent posture to protect all land, inland waters and airspace against external aggression.
- 2. Counter and suppress internal armed threats (e.g., Drug Clan, separatists): Deploy joint task forces to dismantle organised-crime networks and insurgent groups, safeguarding public order.
- 3. **Deter foreign aggression and subversion and information warfare:** Conduct joint exercises, intelligence-sharing, strategic communications and cyber-defence operations to prevent hostile actions and counter misinformation campaigns.
- 4. Support civil authority in times of national crisis (natural disasters, insurgency): Provide disciplined, rule-governed military assistance during natural disasters, publichealth emergencies, economic shocks and large-scale insurgencies.
- 5. Participate in peacekeeping and regional stabilization missions: Contribute trained forces, strategic communications teams and logistics support to UN, AU and subregional missions, reinforcing collective security.
- 6. **Promote national unity, professionalism, and civil-military trust:** Engage traditional leaders and communities in confidence-building measures, uphold the highest standards of military conduct and foster public resilience against economic and information threats.
- 7. Support the sustainability of inclusive economic development and good governance: Embed transparent defence budgeting, parliamentary scrutiny and anti-corruption safeguards and coordinate with economic ministries to secure critical industries and maintain fiscal stability.
- 8. **Sustain Force Readiness and Modernisation:** Right-size personnel, modernise training curricula and invest in command, control, mobility and cyber-defence systems so all units meet declared readiness standards.

3.0 CONCLUSION

These objectives establish a clear defence agenda that directly supports our National Security Strategy. By operationalising deterrence, securing our borders, assisting civil authorities, maintaining readiness, ensuring governance, and strengthening partnerships, we will safeguard Ruekehi's sovereignty and resilience.
